Time for Care & Wellness

Let this summer be the season to take care of your health and well-being. As a Fund member you can use your enhanced Welfare Fund benefits to boost the quality of your life. The **Guardian Dental** plan now covers three cleanings per year. The **Davis Vision** optical benefit, every two years, has no copay if you choose Davis frames or contacts—the better to see your pearly whites. And if it's time to get a hearing aid, the **HearUSA** in-network benefit covers a free exam and \$3,000 (\$1,500 per device), every three years. Availability of The Welfare Fund Plan Description

As a PSC-CUNY Welfare Fund member, the supplemental benefits available to you represent a significant component of your employee or retiree compensation package. They also provide important protection for you and your family in the case of illness or injury. The Fund makes available a **Summary Plan Description (SPD)** as well as the federally mandated **Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC)**, which summarizes important information about any health coverage option in a standard format.

Paper copies of the SPD and SBC may be obtained free of charge by calling **212-354-5230** or by emailing *communications@psccunywf.org*. Regularly updated versions of the SPD and SBC documents are freely available on the Fund website, *psccunywf.org*. (Google: PSC-CUNY Welfare Fund.) Our website is also where you will find detailed explanations of Welfare Fund coverage in plain language, benefit by benefit. There's lots of practical information for making appointments for services, and for contacting our benefits staff, CUNY benefits offices, and retiree services of the New York City Health Benefits Program.
