Availability of The Welfare Fund Plan Description

As a PSC-CUNY Welfare Fund member, the supplemental benefits available to you represent a significant component of your employee or retiree compensation package. They also provide important protection for you and your family in the case of illness or injury. The Fund makes available a **Summary Plan Description (SPD)** as well as the federally mandated **Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC)**, which summarizes important information about any health coverage option in a standard format.

Electronic copies of the SPD and SBC may be obtained by calling **212-354-5230** or by emailing **communications@psccunywf.org**. Regularly updated versions of the SPD and SBC documents are freely available on the Fund website, **psccunywf.org**. (Google: PSC-CUNY Welfare Fund.) Our website is also where you will find detailed explanations of Welfare Fund coverage in plain language, benefit by benefit. There's lots of practical information for making appointments for services, and for contacting our benefits staff, CUNY benefits offices, and retiree services of the New York City Health Benefits Program.
